School Suspension Rules – Parent Agreement

On behalf of School District Four we welcome you and your child to the 2009 Woodruff Youth Football League season. We are excited about this season and the opportunity of partnering with you to make this the best possible experience for our young athletes. It is our goal to give them the very best of chances to learn football fundamentals, further build character; learn about sportsmanship and to develop teamwork skills.

1. In School Suspension: ISS

- a. If a player is going to be placed in ISS **on or before Wednesday** then he is ineligible for the upcoming game on **Saturday of the same week**. If a player goes into ISS on Thursday or Friday, then the suspension will be the following week.
- b. 1st Offense – ½ game suspension (must be first half)
- c. 2nd Offense – 1 game suspension
- d. 3rd Offense – Off of team
- e. If a player has only one offense for the season, then he is still eligible for the All Star game.
- f. Two offenses of ISS, the player will be disqualified from All Star game consideration.

2. Out of School Suspension: OSS

- a. If a player is suspended out of school the player will be disqualified immediately from the team. The disqualification means that a player will not be allowed on the practice facility for the length of the OSS or on the game facility for the one game suspension, which will immediately follow the suspension.
- b. District Four policy states that a student cannot enter District property during the term of the suspension.
- c. Willful violation by a player being at practice during an OSS will result in an immediate disqualification from the team for the remainder of the year.
- d. A head coach that allows a player to practice during this period will be suspended immediately for one week of practice and the next game. Same as player cannot be on either facility.
- e. Absolutely no All Star consideration will be given to a player with an OSS.

Any further discipline violation that warrants a game suspension will result in player disqualification for the season

3. Sportsmanship: Player, Coach and Parent

- a. It is our goal to stress the importance of sportsmanship to our players so that this can be a safe and fun league for them to play in.
- b. If a player is penalized for Unsportsmanlike Conduct for punching another player or using profanity the player will be ejected and suspended for the next game.
- c. If a player is penalized for Unsportsmanlike Conduct for any other reason then the Head Official and Administrator will review for possible penalties.
- d. If a coach is penalized for Unsportsmanlike Conduct the Head Official and administrator will review for possible penalties or fines.
- e. If a parent is heard using profanity, being abusive to a player, coach or official, threatening a player, coach or official the parent will be asked to leave the premises immediately and the League Administrator will review the incident. The parent will be notified on Monday of the consequences.
